"Make a Collaborative Story About Space!"

Embark on an intergalactic journey with your family! In this collaborative storytelling activity, each family member will contribute one sentence to create a magical story set among the stars.

Materials Needed:

- Your imagination!

To do this activity, one family member will start off your story by saying one sentence, then they will pass it along to the next family member, who will say another sentence, and this will continue until your collaborative story reaches a satisfying conclusion. If you want some prompts to start off with, here are a few space-themed ones below:

- "Once upon a time, a brave cat visited the moon and found . . ."
- "A lonely little alien lived all by himself on Mars until one day . . ."
- "Once upon a time, in a galaxy far, far away, [insert your child's name] found a lightsaber buried in the sand of a mysterious planet."

How did your story change from the beginning to the end? Who were the characters? What did they do? Did anything unexpected happen?

- Fosters creativity and imagination as family members collaborate to create a unique story set in outer space
- Encourages communication and teamwork as family members take turns contributing to the narrative
- Promotes bonding and quality time spent together as you embark on a shared storytelling adventure
