### PLAN FOR A SUCCESSFUL OVERNIGHT ADVENTURE

**LEADERS:** Provide this form to each parent prior to your overnight.

- Overnight Adventures are offered to a minimum of 50 children and maximum of 300 total participants. Your group must bring one chaperone for every five children.
- Arrive at SCI between 6:00 and 6:15 pm for check-in. Orientation starts at 6:45 pm and is required for everyone. A chaperone-only training
  will occur while students attend their first program. Driving directions are available at <a href="www.sciowa.org">www.sciowa.org</a>, and discounted parking passes for
  the handicap-accessible ramp located north of SCI can be purchased at the Box Office upon arrival when you sign in.
- If you are running late, please call the Box Office at 515-274-6868 ext. 228. In case of severe weather, SCI will contact you with cancellation information by noon the day of your Overnight Adventure and will make every effort to reschedule.
- Arrive with all necessary items, including sleeping bags, pillows, toiletries and comfortable sleeping clothes. Temperatures fluctuate in the building, so be prepared for anything! You may bring a twin-sized air mattress, but we kindly request that you do not bring cots.
- Complete emergency contact and permission forms for each group member and mail to SCI (400 W. Martin Luther King Jr. Pkwy, Attn: Guided Learning, Des Moines, IA, 50309). Every person in your group MUST have complete paperwork and emergency contact information.
- A typical Overnight Adventure is scheduled as follows. Exact schedule varies per group:

6:00 - 6:30 pm: Registration

6:45 pm: Parent, chaperone and child orientation - REQUIRED

7:00 pm: Private live program / Chaperone-only orientation

7:30 pm: Private Star Theater show

8:00 pm: Time to explore SCI

9:30 pm: Set up campsite and get ready for bed 10:00 pm: IMAX showing & snack (popcorn)

11:00 pm: Lights out!

7:00 am: Continental breakfast

8:00 - 10:00 am: Time to explore SCI

10:00 am: SCI opens and overnight guests can stay to explore SCI at no extra charge

- For safety reasons, all Overnight Adventurers (youth and adult) must remain with your group and within the SCI building from 6:30 pm to 10:00 am. If you have any reason to leave SCI during that time, notify an SCI staff member to direct you. Doors are generally locked after 6:30 pm.
- Locker rental is available for small personal items at \$.50 each time it is opened. SCI is not responsible for loss or theft, and we recommend that all electronic games, toys, personal music devices and other valuable items be left at home.
- There will be a complimentary evening snack and light breakfast provided, so please notify SCI at least 5 days before your Overnight Adventure if you have special dietary needs. Outside food or drinks are not allowed unless special arrangements are made in advance. If you'd like to purchase a pizza dinner for your group, contact the SCI Sales Office at 515-274-6868 ext. 222 at least 1 week in advance. Please be aware that SCI's Food Chain Café may not be open in the evening, as SCI normally closes at 5:00 pm on Fridays.
- Each group should designate a person responsible for First Aid and medications and have on-hand any permission forms as required by
  your organization. Adventurers may self-administer medication if approved by your designated chaperone. Refrigeration for medication is
  available.
- Overnight Adventures can be designed for special programming and to earn a scout badge. Contact SCI's Guided Learning Manager at 515-274-6868 ext. 281 to consider the possibility.
- SCI's A-ha! Gift Store will be open for a period of time, either at night or in the morning. Encourage your group to bring pocket money for souvenirs, but please consider collecting the money for safekeeping until the group has access to the shop.
- Chaperones must ensure that all Adventurers depart safely after an excellent Overnight Adventure!




- Exit I-235 on Martin Luther King Jr. Pkwy

- Turn East onto Market Street to the SCI entrance


#### FROM THE EAST
